Eligibility: Athletes U14 to U18, Masters. Specifically, athletes born 2009 and up. U12 athletes will be allowed if space permits at coach's discretion.

Athletes must be registered with their provincial Alpine Race Organization and have a valid National Points card.

Race suits are allowed for all racers.

Approved helmets must be worn by all athletes and forerunners.

Quota: First come, First served. Max 150 racers. Club Blocking of entries may result in denial of entry.

Registration: Race registration is through AlpinePoints.ca race portal under 'Timmins Slalom Derby' or by official FIS entry forms(available on TSR Resource page). Registrations requested by March 16th, 2022; final ACA deadline is March 23rd. Submit manual entries to: Daryl Brain, Chief of Calculations/Timing, dbrainiac@mac.com

Deadline for submission is **March 7th** if you wish to guarantee hoodie sizes

- Entry Fees: \$250.00 per athlete, payable by cash or cheque.
 Includes race fees, three racer lunches, lift tickets, race hoodie.
 Payment by cheque (preferred) or cash can be made the morning of March 25 when bibs are picked up at the TSR race headquarters. Payable to TIMMINS SKI RACERS. If not paid, the athlete will be removed from the event.
- Notes: 1) Coach Lift Tickets Coaches will receive lift tickets 8:1; or where fewer than 8 athletes per club entry 1 coach ticket. Additional passes are the clubs responsibility to purchase.
 - 2) There will be hoodies provided to all participating athletes. Coaches are asked to provide shirt sizing for athletes and submit the online form by March 7, 2022 to ensure proper sizing.

- **Protests:** Delivered in writing with Video to the Referee accompanied by \$100.00 cash. According to ICR (FIS) Book, 2021 Edition, sec.640-644
- **Bib Deposit:** \$100.00 per team, by cheque, payable to **Timmins Ski Racers Inc.**Bib deposits will be returned after all bibs have been returned.
- **Rules:** According to ICR (FIS) Book, 2021 Edition and applicable ACA & AOA guidelines. Local race rules may apply.
- **Seeding:** By National Points. Un-carded athletes will be seeded separately using a computer generated starting order.
- **Results/Awards:** Medals will be awarded to the top (3) finishers (male & female) for each age group. Medals will be awarded each day at Mount Jamieson Resort. Coaches will be emailed official results and results will be uploaded to Alpine Points after the weekend is complete. Please ensure legible emails are recorded at the Captains' Meeting.
- Covid Considerations: The Northern Ontario Division requires proof of covid vaccination for all athletes, official and volunteers at the event. Proof must be available upon request and failure to provide proof of vaccination will result in removal from the event. Masks must be worn at all times when indoors. Masks are required outdoors when social distancing is not possible. Because of ongoing pandemic concerns, TSR will not be hosting a Derby Banquet this year.
